

HEARS HIS DAUGHTERS ARE SHIPWRECKED

Abraham Wax, of 619 Kalghn avenue, Camden, received word yesterday that his daughters, Hilda, aged 15 years, and Harna, aged 12 years, were on the steamer Manchester Skipper, ashore on Petrie's Ledges, on the east coast of Cape Breton.

Some time since Wax sent money to his daughters in Russia to come to this country. When they arrived in London they found that the steamship agent at their home had decamped with their money and several thousand dollars belonging to immigrants.

The girls were taken in charge by a Hebrew society and sent to Havre, France. They sailed from there on October 5, bound for Montreal. Mr. Wax spent a large sum of money trying to locate his daughters after learning of their misfortune in London. The first news he received was of the shipwreck. He has gone to Nova Scotia to bring them home.
